SUBJECT: NWCG Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist Decal

**Purpose:** NWCG has approved a Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist Decal intended for placement in the *Incident Response Pocket Guide* (*IRPG*), PMS 461. It is recommended the decal be placed on page 120 of the 2018 *IRPG*, opposite the existing Briefing Checklist. The decal should be used to supplement your fire and operational briefings to encourage open and honest discussion to help protect yourself, your crew, and your camp. Please distribute this information through your agency channels.

**Issue/Action**: The *IRPG* is the one guide all firefighters utilize on a regular basis, carry on assignment, and are the most familiar with. The Fire and COVID-19 Briefing Checklist decal will be easily accessible during wildfire operations for briefings or personal review. The decal will be printed with orange background and available to order as NFES 2646 in packages of 100 by mid-July.
