

**NWCG CURRICULUM MANAGEMENT ISSUE PAPER #124
ASSIGNMENT OF COURSE NAME AND NUMBER FOR THE NEW
LEADERSHIP COURSE
September 4, 2014**

BACKGROUND

The NWCG Leadership Subcommittee, under the NWCG Training Committee, was tasked to establish a new leadership course as defined in Issue Paper #114.

Developing a course specifically for IMT Leadership during incident response falls in the line with the L-380 to L-381 migration, and fills an important training gap. The course will serve as advancement from L-381 for operational personnel as well as IMT-destined support personnel following their position-specific training and mentoring assignments.

See Appendix A for an illustration of the dual-track L-series curriculum.

CURRENT STATUS

The Leadership Subcommittee has developed course criteria for this course similar to the design of L-380 and L-381. These criteria will be certified and vendors will develop course content to support the criteria. The course is designed as a dual path to the L-480, Organizational Leadership course, and is targeted toward personnel serving in the Command and General Staff positions; it addresses specific skills, tools and philosophies these practitioners are expected to have.

RECOMMENDATION

Assign this course the number and name: L-481, Leadership for Command and General Staff. Assign maintenance responsibility for L-481 course to the Leadership Subcommittee.
