# **Decision Paper #7**

24 May 2019

**Subject:** Change to M-581 Fire Program Management course for Unit Fire Program Manager Positions and General Updates

**Effective Date:** This decision is effective on July 1, 2019.

**Background:** The Fire Management Board (FMB) has received a request to change the *M-581 Fire Program Management* course from a condition of hire (selective placement factor) to a condition of employment for Unit Fire Program Manager (UFPM) Positions.

**Decision:** The DOI Bureaus will administer the M-581 training requirement for Unit Fire Program Managers as a condition of employment to be completed within one year of entry on duty. The USDA Forest Service will continue to administer M-581 required as a condition of hire (selective placement factor) for UFPM applicants.

**Implementation:** DOI Bureaus will ensure that all changes to automated staffing systems for positions impacted by this change are completed prior to July 1, 2019. Bureaus will identify M-581 as a condition of employment for UFPM positions after July 1, 2019. Please reference the attached updated IFPM Position Matrix.

The IFPM Standard and all supporting materials available on the IFPM website have been updated.

**Scope:** The revisions as outlined in this decision paper apply to all recruitment and qualification determinations effective July 1, 2019.

## **General Updates:**

24 May 2019

**Aviation Qualifications:** Upon issuance of the October 1, 2018 National Incident Management System: Wildland Fire Qualification System Guide (PMS 310-1) the Helibase Type 1 (HEB1) and Helibase Type 2 (HEB2) positions have been combined to Helibase Manager (HEBM) positions. All references to HEB1 and HEB2 have been changed to HEBM in the IFPM standard and IFPM Position Matrix.

**Course Name and Number Changes:** In June 2017, the National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) Executive Board approved the following actions:

- Local Fire Management Leadership (LFML) and M-581, Fire Program Management courses have been combined and will be delivered as M-581, Fire Program Management An Overview.
- The *National Fire Management Leadership (NFML)* course has been assigned the M-582 course number and retitled: *Fire Program Management Leading Complex Programs*.

Specific information regarding this change can be located at the <u>NWCG website</u>. This change impacts the NWCG additional required training requirements for Unit Fire Program Manager, Geographic Fire Program Manager and National Fire Program Manager positions identified in the IFPM Standard.

This change has resulted in the following modifications to the UFPM, GFPM and NFPM position requirements:

#### **Unit Fire Program Manager**

Additional required training as presented in the following courses or agency equivalent:

• M-581, Fire Program Management – An Overview

#### Geographic Fire Program Manager (GFPM) and National Fire Program Manager (NFPM)

Additional required training as presented in the following courses or agency equivalent:

• M-581, Fire Program Management – An Overview or M-582 Fire Program Management – Leading Complex Programs

Previous completion of Local Fire Management Leadership (LFML) or M-581, Fire Program Management or National Fire Management Leadership (NFML) also meets the additional required training requirement for these positions.
