

## S-420: Command and General Staff (Instructor-Led Training) Summary of Changes – 2020

## **Overall Course Format Changes**

- Course duration of 38 hours changed to 42-44 hours. This reflects 2 hours of additional instructor-led training, and 2-4 hours of enhanced mandatory pre-course work.
- Course objectives and unit objectives have been updated.
- Course composition changed from 7 units (with sub-lessons) to 16 units.
- Instructional material added that addresses decision support tools, strategic planning, risk management, and Agency Administrator interaction. This material is in alignment with the more in-depth curriculum on these topics that is presented in S-520.
- Course evaluation is based upon a student evaluation and feedback rubric that is used to evaluate each student, to enhance their knowledge and skills development.
- The course is designed to allow students to participate regardless of primary trainee position or functional area background.
