# South Canyon Fire – Discussion Points

## **Strategic Discussion #1**

Location: Two Rivers Park

You are an Agency Administrator and this is a summary of the morning briefing. Your area has been receiving numerous lighting strikes. Four geographic areas have significant fire activity; nationally the Planning Level is 5. You have about 40 fires in your home unit.

- Twenty-three (23) carry-over fires from previous days.
- Fifteen (15) new fires reported today.
- Two (2) are larger than 5 acres.
- Three (3) are smaller than 5 acres.
- Ten (10) are unverified smoke sightings and minor fires monitored from a distance.

Of the carry-over fires, you are actively fighting two (the rest are in monitor status):

- A 1600-acre fire is under control and in the demobilization phase with crews being reassigned elsewhere,
- A 50-acre fire has 4 engines and 23 firefighters assigned; may be under control in 24 hours.
- Given this scenario, which players on your home unit would you coordinate with to ensure appropriate actions are taken?
- What fire preparedness and management planning activities do you focus on prior to the onset of fire season at your home unit?

# **Strategic Discussion #2** Location: Trailhead • What were the wildland fire services strengths and weaknesses prior to 1994? • What have you done different in the last few years to make firefighters on your home unit more safe and effective?

### **Strategic Discussion #3**

Location: Overlook Ridge

- What areas in your home unit give you most concern for firefighter safety?
- What do you think the firefighters on the South Canyon Fire knew about the local weather patterns?

### **Strategic Discussion #4**

Location: Overlook

	managers, and administrators. How do you display a safe culture in your home unit?

- As a Unit FMO, Center Manager or Agency Administrator, how comfortable would you be with your ICT3's on a fire with the terrain challenges that you see here?
- How would you respond to an ICT3 on your home unit if they turned down an assignment?
