#### CIMT and AA Evaluation Forms

• NMAC reviewing final drafts prior to issuance. A letter to all geographic areas will announce the availability of the forms for use; the link and form in the *Interagency Standards for Fire and Fire Aviation Operations* will be updated as well.

#### Agency-Specific AA Training and Qualification Requirements

- Standard likely needs to come from DOI level (or OWF) to ensure adoption through the bureaus.
- Assessment and self-assessment forms from the *NWCG Standards for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)*, PMS 309, <u>https://www.nwcg.gov/publications/pms309</u>, hold potential for adaptation into an AA-specific form and process.
  - Establish a few high-level, broad competencies for review and discussion.
- The assessments coupled with recommendation for all AAs to attend M-581, Fire Program Management, An Overview could be a good starting point for a baseline interagency standard for AAs that would be agreeable to all agencies/entities.
  - Assessment would provide a document to be used by a mentor/coach/shadow AA for a less experienced AA and provide quantifiable areas for growth and experience.
  - Include examples of self-assessment to demonstrate applicable experience and certificates (provide what right looks like).
- Next actions:
  - Continue to review the RPL documents and discuss with agency peers and fire managers the options for baseline training.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Begin to compile AA competencies to build draft assessments.
