National Greening Team

- Team has been developing recommendations and tools to help meet Executive Order 14057. Need for leadership engagement to make a bigger impact and adopt practices as standard expectations, both for local units/initial attack and for large incidents.
 - Have used spring incident management team (IMT) meetings as a place for outreach. Generally present during logistics breakouts, which misses the larger audience of general sessions.
- Cost savings to be achieved on wholistic level but cultural and habitual challenges still exist.
- Services encouraged include composting, mobile water treatment systems, and recycling. Other options are solar generators and rechargeable batteries.

- Clear expectations should be included in leader's intent and/or delegation of authority for IMTs.
 - Recommend developing tiers of actions, to create measurable expectations and give IMTs more specific expectations than the current draft language contains.
- Recommendations for education and outreach include annual refresher modules (RT-130), IMT sessions, agency pre-season meetings, etc.
- Follow up agenda item to continuing discussing how AA Subgroup can assist.
 - Begin communicating with agency peers and leadership, along with current Greening Team ambassadors.
