CIM AA Subgroup Recommendations Sarah Fisher provided the group with the recommendations from the CIM AA subgroup. There was a brief discussion where the entire group expressed approval/agreement with the recommendations.	
 PSOG Discussion NPS is hosting 2 positions. PDs were made it through classification and are 12/13 instead of a flat 13. NTEs, 1 to 5 years with the possibility to convert. IFEC came back with 3 year BILL funding. The 3rd position approved by FMB currently has a detailer in the chair. Waiting for funding and then will move that person into the NTE position. Governance issues continue to be a point of discussion. PSOG is wanting a supervisory chain of command. Strategic planning continues to problem solve and come up with the best option for governance. 	
 Miscellaneous NMAC chair changed from Shane MacDonald to Jim Shults Jesse Bender continues to work on the CIM-FEC memo. Potentially a cover letter from FMB to show concurrence.
