<p>Welcome</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Federal Wildland Firefighter Health and Wellbeing Program: Standardized template for exposure notification. Written in alignment with Office of Safety and Health (OSH) requirements Authority would be with the Agency Administrator to sign letter. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Creating consistent guidance and templates at incidents for responders <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will provide a level of documentation. Promoted for use as needed, not on every fire. Idea is to provide time and location specific documentation if a responder needs to later prove exposure, ie Valley Fever. Indicator that something occurred but it does not preclude other methods of tracking, ie presumptive illness. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Includes coverage for primary firefighters and all employees who participate in incident response and fuels work. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review template and informational bulletin.
