ASSIGNMENT OF COURSE TITLE AND NUMBER TO RESOURCE ADVISOR, FIRELINE COURSE

BACKGROUND

The Resource Advisor, Fireline (REAF) position will be included in the *NWCG Standards for Wildland Fire Position Qualifications*, PMS 310-1 in 2026. In preparation for this a position analysis was completed, during which the Incident Position Description (IPD) was evaluated, and Incident Position Standards and a Next Generation Position Task Book (PTB) for REAF were created. During the analysis, subject matter experts (SMEs) identified a need for a position-specific training course to develop skills needed by a REAF. This course of action was supported and approved by the position steward committee.

CURRENT STATUS

The NWCG Incident Position Standards for Resource Advisor, Fireline, PMS 350-112 and NWCG Position Task Book for Resource Advisor, Fireline (REAF), PMS 311-112 have been approved. The curriculum for the REAF course, M-280, Resource Advisor, Fireline, has been reviewed and approved by the position steward committee, with imminent certification pending.
