1. Short Term Plan Update

Things are going well. Chuck and Nick are compiling all the notes and will have a report ready early next year.

2. Long Term Plan Update

Working with Heath, Larry, and Cheryl Bright. Things are going really well. Delving into a lot of old reports and compiling it all.
