Two major gaps were identified – public and non-federal entities’ lack of support and lack of decision support for fire management and coordination at the GACCs and Type 1-2 IMTs.

Reasons for these gaps are well-documented and the issues have been raised frequently by different agencies though nothing has been resolved.

Several different proposal options for working towards resolution.

Phil - Could various regions provide state support and at least help on the back end?

Derrek – On the interagency model, some of this could be provided by the states.

Predictive services has never been fully staffed as was initially intended, and should be filled with the top down approach and staff the various levels.

Funding should come from the top so there aren’t as many dispersed down issues.

What would the best rollout strategy be?

Sean – We need to do whatever needed in PSOG to make the plan presentable.

Brian – The plan needs more detail added into it. How was the required FTE calculated? In the current system, there’s more buy-in because right now, the managers have more control.
