**SUBJECT:** RX-301 and RX-341 Delivery Recommendations

The Fuels Management Committee encourage geographic areas to deliver RX-301, Prescribed Fire Implementation and RX-341, Prescribed Fire Burn Plan Preparation as separate courses whenever feasible. When separate delivery is not feasible, allow for RX-301 and RX-341 to be delivered in a combined format.

When delivering in a combined format, the following requirements must be met:

- Pre-selection assessments for both courses may be administered separately or combined into a single assessment. A minimum score of 70% is required on all assessments for acceptance into the course.
- A minimum of 44 instructor-led training hours are required. This includes 32 hours for the entirety of RX-341 and 12 additional hours for RX-301.
- NWCG certificates for both RX-301 and RX-341 will be awarded for successful completion of the combined delivery.
