Subject: Prescribed Fire Manager Transition Plan

Background: The Incident and Position Standard Committee (IPSC) has approved a request from the Fuels Management Committee (FMC) to combine Prescribed Fire Manager Type 1 (RXM1) and Prescribed Fire Manager Type 2 (RXM2) into Prescribed Fire Manager (RXMG). The FMC should utilize this transition plan to communicate the change to the field.

Coordination: The current RXM1 and RXM2 Position Task Books (PTB) will be merged into one RXMG PTB.

Transition Plan

Effective Date: The change will be effective on October 1, 2020 when the NWCG Standards for Wildland Fire Position Qualifications is annually updated.

Current Qualified RXM1 and RXM2: To minimize the impact to the field, the process of historical recognition for the RXMG position will be used for all current qualified RXM1 and RXM2 upon updating to the NWCG Position Catalog on October 1, 2020. The qualified responders will be transitioned to the RXMG mnemonic and will follow the new currency requirement as of the transition date.

Current Trainee RXM1 and RXM2: Current RXM1 and RXM2 trainees will transitioned to a RXMG trainee status on October 1, 2020. The trainee will need to meet the new qualification standard for RXMG requirements. Trainees will transition to the new RXMG PTB; however, documentation of the position performance in the RXM1 or RXM2 PTB should still be considered toward certification. Trainees initiating a new PTB after October 1, 2020 will use the new RXMG PTB.
