This memorandum is in response to the Request for Change (RFC) that was submitted on June 22nd, 2020, titled NWCG Standards for Wildland Fire Resource Typing, PMS 200 - Type 2 Crew Standard. The Incident and Position Standards Committee (IPSC) has denied the request to modify Type II Crew requirements to include three basic fallers.

IPSC shared this proposal with the Hazard Tree Working Group and it was their consensus that this would put a Type 2 Crew in a situation with nobody to supervise the basic fallers during falling operations.
