Subject: January 2022 Updates to NWCG Standards for Wildland Fire Position

Qualifications, PMS 310-1

The following changes have been requested by position stewards and approved by the Incident Position and Standards Committee (IPSC).

Aircraft Timekeeper (ATIM) – Remove A-107 and A-104.

Engine Boss (ENGB) – Add ENGB maintains currency of ICT5.

Geographic Information System Specialist (GISS) –Add Required Training S-341 and RT-341.

Initial Attack Dispatcher (IADP) – Remove A-107.

Ramp Manager (RAMP) - Remove A-107.

Additionally, IPSC made the following changes to the web based *NWCG Standards for Wildland Fire Position Qualifications* PMS 310-1: referencing the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) publication, process updates for requesting new positions and changes to existing positions and other minor clarifying language updates. These changes will be reflected prior to January 31, 2022 in conjunction with release of the RPL publication.

The position qualification requirements on the individual position pages of the <u>NWCG Position</u> <u>Catalog</u> will be updated and position qualification requirements changes will be effective in the qualifications systems on January 21, 2022.
