Purpose: This revised memorandum corrects implementation dates described in IPSC-2022-03 for the SITL position changes. The IPSC-2022-03 memorandum contents are otherwise unchanged.

Action: As a result of review of PMS 310-1 changes and work on endorsements, errors were recognized on the position qualifications requirements pages in the position catalog for the PIOT and SITL positions. As a result, the following changes will be made:

- PIOT Addition of the FEMA *An Introduction to the National Incident Management System*, IS-700.b course as required training. **Change effective immediately.**
- SITL Addition of the FEMA An Introduction to the National Incident Management System, IS-700.b, Introduction to the Incident Command System, ICS-100, Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response, ICS-200 courses as required training. Change effective May 2, 2022.

Background and Coordination: During the addition of the PIOT position in January 2022 and when the Incident Commander Type 4 prerequisite experience requirement was removed from the SITL position in 2015, the position qualification requirements of IS-700 for PIOT and IS-700, ICS-100 and ICS-200 for the SITL position were inadvertently excluded from the qualification requirement pages.
