Subject: Close Incident and Position Standards Committee Request for Change 2023-02 for

Demobilization Unit Leader (DMOB) Prerequisite Change

Purpose: This memorandum closes the Incident and Position Standards Committee (IPSC) Request for Change (RFC) 2023-02 received from the National Association of State Foresters to change required experience for Demobilization Unit Leader (DMOB) from satisfactory performance as a Resources Unit Leader (RESL) to Status/Check-In Recorder (SCKN). The RFC was assigned to the Incident Planning Subcommittee (IPS).

Action: Effective immediately and in collaboration with IPS, IPSC will close RFC 2023-02 since the DMOB position will be analyzed under the Incident Performance and Training Modernization (IPTM) effort starting in Spring 2024. Analysis under IPTM includes creation of a performance support package, which includes an incident position description, incident position standards, a Next Generation position task book, and any related training materials or other supporting products, and other changes recommended by subject matter experts and approved by IPS, as the position steward, and IPSC.
