Fire restrictions website update (Kenny)

- This used to be firerestrictions.us but the server is no longer available. Forest Service regions 3 (R3) and 1 (R1) are looking to find a host site and redeveloping this site. R3 is moving aggressively to build a site on the AGOL platform with maps, etc., through New Mexico's fire information and restrictions page. Looking at utilizing a permanent site withing NWCG site to host the site/or put the link on it. This site was well-liked by the public because it was so much easier for them to find information in one place, based on locations on a map, for all county, state, and federal lands.
- Proposal: Kenny to get proposal from working group and present to CEPC for vote to move forward. If motion passes, then NWCG IT would need to be asked to take it forward. Scope, funding, project plan would all need to be part of this proposal. Annie will also look into what NWCG procedure is.

NPS (Tina): No update.

USDA FS (Gwen): The national community wildfire mitigation program manager position is open and closes Feb. 18th. This is a 301 12/13. Tina shared the vacancy announcement. Please share this opportunity. We continue to work on editing the Outdoor fire Safety brochure and moving that through the approval process within the Forest Service. Guidance regarding the repeal of the 711 and 711a laws referencing a criminal offense for using Smokey Bear and Woodsy Owl's images was explained in the Prevention and Mitigation Post that was sent out to CEPC members. The Forest Service still has laws that make it a civil offense to utilize his image and slogan and we will continue to diligently go after use infringements.

P-101 was offered in the SW region and there were over 60 participants.

P-301 will be offered also by the SW region, but it was postponed until the week of March 3, 2021. This fire prevention planning course will also be offered the week of March 23rd. Participation has been capped to around 25 participants in each course.

The National Agriculture Library and the Forest Service are working on renewing the MOU that officially designates the NAL as the collector of Smokey Bear non-record material and items. This will increase the cataloging and conservation of these historic items.
