 - We plan to finalize the IPDs and the qual sheets to put in the RFQ for the PIO3 and PIOT the week of March 22. CEPC will be able to review next week as soon as I can get everything together and approved by PIOSC.
 - The next steps will be to review the PIO task books and write a transition plan for the new positions. We will work on these products next week in workshops.

DISCUSSION TOPICS

Complex Incident Management – Jesse Bender (20 minutes) - <u>Storymap</u>. Recommendation – bring everyone to an equal scale – not the same as everyone getting T1 quals. Need to create an environment where we just have a team and we go into a complex incident and manage it.

- Equitability
- Simplified workforce model
- Streamlining, including T3 IMTs
