COMMITTEE BUSINESS:

- Chair's update Tina:
 - Terri Jenkins update: Due to Terri's situation, CEPC will need representation from the US
 Fish and Wildlife Service. Currently the Chair is seeking interested qualified candidate to fill
 Terri's seat on the Committee.
 - Strategic Plan meeting October 5-7, 9:00-11:00 MT
 - Meeting call-in number: Next month there is a possibility that this will be available to CEPC members.

Promoting a better understanding of wildland fire through communication, education, prevention and outreach.

- Introducing Doug Hildebrand did round robin of introductions
- NWCG Coordinator remarks and news and update Deb: Huge staffing vacancy issues. Have been on a lot of interview panels, across the board. Working with Jerry, Candy, Fred and Zach to update references, making sure webpages are up to date. Validating "leadership levels" for various subcommittees.
- Fire Prevention Education Team Subcommittee update Fred: Lot of early movement of teams, Gwen is on FPET assignment. This has brought a lot of things to light – had had good rotation and structure, but have discovered need to go deeper than 2 teams on the bubble – e.g. getting out as single resources. Need to get to qualifications of PETM and PETL wrapped up and in line with what subcommittee feels is needed. No course requirement; all you need is I-100 and I-700 – need to address that and take it on pretty soon.
- Wildland Fire Investigation Subcommittee update Jerry: CEPC met Shaun Zimmermaker last meeting as vice chair of subcommittee; comes from long line of NWCG participants in northern California. PMS-412 revision is main thing going on; John Bird was leading task group – when he resigned, Shaun stepped forward to lead – hopefully button up by spring 2022. First week of November subcommittee meeting in Reno – second week with be FI-310 Beta 2. First full week of June, ran 3 FI-210 classes through the learning portal.
- PIO Subcommittee update Tina: PIOs out on assignment, only had a couple participants at last meeting, so deferred agenda.
