#### **COMMITTEE BUSINESS:**

- <u>Chair's update Tina:</u> Brittany Wike is interested in possibly joining CEPC and becoming notetaker. Tina attended the Connections call last week and provided an update. U.S. is still sending resources to Canada this will likely continue.
- NWCG Coordinator remarks and news and update Sarah:
- o IPTM: The first 5 IPTM positions for CY2023 have begun or will begin their weeklong in-person analysis this month and next. The second 5 positions (ICT5, FIRB, FELB, FFT2, and ENGB) will start this fall. Currently in the process of identifying the IPTM positions for CY2024, and I have already started advocating PIOT/PIO3 and PETM/PETL positions to be included in 2024.
- Hiring: The vice-Blake GS-13 Coordinator position was announced on Tuesday and closes on 7/24.
   There are also 3 BLM and 1 USFS GS-9 Writer/Editor detail announcements currently open (FS closes 7/14 and BLM 3 close 7/20).
- <u>PIO Subcommittee update Chris:</u> Chris was in the field yesterday with the Deputy Secretary of Interior yesterday, looking at some projects and talking about some of the firefighter initiatives. Adrienne from the PIOSC presented the WFIT Board with a memo the PIOSC worked on, with some concerns on Inciweb/Drupal, with some suggestions to address concerns. PIOSC is working on the IWDG tasking regarding short surge capacity for individuals/modules, etc. for the Information functional area; meetings have been going well and they're compiling lots of good ideas and will be meeting twice more this month. Chris is available for questions if anyone has any.

## Communication, Education, and Prevention Committee (CEPC)

- <u>Fire Prevention Education Team Subcommittee update Mark/Maureen:</u> AZ and NM have FPET teams out right now. Both publications the subcommittee has been working on are officially approved and published: standards/guide for FPETS and the host unit guide. Eclipse products are available at the cache, and the toolkit will be available soon.
- Wildland Fire Investigation Subcommittee update Shawn: Not on call. Update via Tina: status quo at this point. They're working with the National Fire Academy for investigation courses. USFS will provide location; USFS and CAL Fire will provide instructors. Potential for invest Technician Position now looking at expanding FI-210 instead.

#### **DISCUSSION TOPICS**

#### Topic

- Fire Danger courses 191/291 SME input (Maureen). For the National Fire Danger Rating System, there are currently no classes; looking to develop 191 and 291. A group has been working on developing the course material. They have developed a 4-minute introductory video as part as the 191 class, working with the University of Idaho; the video needs more info on rating system and how it relates to prevention. For both the course content and video, they first need to identify the positions that would use NFDRS and reach out to those NWCG committees to get SMEs to comment and participate at this stage of development. PTEM, PIOF, Investigation, CEPC would have interest/ownership for 191. For 291 engine bosses, prevention team leader, PIO. They will be reaching out to CEPC and subcommittees (via the Chair) to get some SMEs to work with them on course material (editing/reviewing). Unsure of timeframe at this point.
- Discussion about glossary term Wildland Urban Interface, owned by FMB (Tina). Currently capitalized in
  the glossary. Term originally comes from the 2000 National Fire Plan. Now that we're years past that,
  should it be capitalized? CEPC's consensus was to have the WUI committee help to determine this Tina
  will email the chair (Faith is on the WUI committee). After working with WUI, we can go back to FMB
  (through NWCG/Sarah).
