COMMITTEE BUSINESS:

- <u>Chair's update Carrie</u>: F2F annual meeting at the Schoodic Institute in Maine, Oct 7-11; the meeting space has been secured, and Kent is looking into how we can do the funding piece. Attending the NWCG Annual Meeting to be held in person, February 21-22, Boise Centre. Carrie is finalizing meeting notes from last year. Maureen's retirement Mandy will get this group more info on donating to a gift card for Maureen.
- NWCG Coordinator remarks and news and update Katy: Annual meeting for NWCG coming up in February (invite/agenda has gone out) in Boise Feb. 21-22. Starting to move quickly on positions in IPTM. PIO-T and PIO-3 are set to go in the next batch; Katy will talk with the PIOSC at their next meeting about nailing down SME for this effort. Per Katy, funding requests for PIO training will be a non-issue for this year due to upcoming changes.
- <u>PIO Subcommittee update Chris:</u> Held a couple special topic sessions recently. Continuing to work with the Inciweb group (business lead and development team) on ongoing education/awareness of changes related to going to Drupal. Looking at getting some additional members into the subcommittee to fill vacancies (BIA, USFWS, BLM) have identified a BLM person, but looking for other agency reps. - <u>Fire Prevention Education Team Subcommittee update Mark:</u> Currently teaching a P-301 course; will be a P-310 course coming up week after next in Arcadia. In the process of looking at/adding content to the Prevention Team Leader PD and will submit when ready. Submitted a request for people to sign up for the national schedule. Subcommittee meeting coming up next week; will discuss whether we have any funding requests potential. For P-310, looking into whether we can update the course test to better reflect the course (this is the only potential funding need for FY25).
- Wildland Fire Investigation Subcommittee update Shawn: Continuing on PMS-412 and FI-210; hope to have photograph updates done by next week; then will cleanup some language and do basic editing before ready for publishing. Submitted 3 proposals for studies to different research institutions: hoping to get studies going on the reliability of fire pattern indicators and on leveraging technology to help in fire investigations. Had committee meeting last week and have been in touch with Katy and will likely submit 2 budget requests: one to update investigations training and another for a professional editor for reviewing PMS-412.
