June 12th 2024 0900-1008

- 1. Participants: Chris, Dan, Nathan, David Schultz, Brent, Mitch, Rocco, Nicole
- 2. IPTM Process for FBAN/LTAN (David S.)
 - a. Incident Performance and Training Modernization
 - b. Hoping to get a decision on which positions will go into the 2025 IPTN
 - i. Hoping for 30 positions for next round
 - ii. 1st group was 10 positions and this spring 16 more
 - iii. Next Feb...hoping for another 30
 - iv. Decision within the next week or so
 - v. FBAN and LTAN high on the list so odds are good
 - c. Some work can be done this summer if FBAN/LTAN gets put in the hopper
 - d. PPT presented (will be placed in FBS sharepoint)
 - i. Systems Improvement started as a Board tasking in 2015
 - ii. Goals of IPTM
 - 1. Performance based process to allow trainees to move thru the training system as quickly and efficiently as possible
 - 2. New task books will be created, simplified and tied to the new Incident Position Standards
 - 3. Move as much of the training to on the job or in the field
 - 4. Keep training to position specific
 - 5. Look for opportunities to create job aids that can be updated easier
 - iii. Look at every position in PMS 310-1
 - 1. Around 130 positions
 - iv. As new information comes in, create a system that is allowable for changes.
 - v. Reduce redundancies in task book
 - 1. Ex. Almost everyone has a "Have a kit" statement
 - vi. Scope and Deliverables
 - 1. Incident Position Description IPD
 - 2. Incident Position Standards
 - 3. Next Gen Position Task Book (PTB)
 - 4. Performance Support Tools (training & job aids)
 - 5. Updated Position Page on NWCG site
 - vii. Position Steward
 - 1. Lots of discussion about this internally
 - 2. This committee is steward for FBAN and LTAN

- 3. Work closely with IPSC and other identified stakeholders to establish quals requirements
- 4. 3 main items
 - a. Establish standards
 - b. Develop Qualification requirements
 - c. Create Training and performance support products
- viii. SME's are key to this effort!
 - 1. Looking for around 7 established SME's
 - 2. Generally, travel needs to be paid for by the home unit but there is some flexibility for some entities
 - a. State and USFS has set aside a little bit of \$\$\$ for this effort
 - 3. SME recruitment vide has been created and use the "Button" to submit whether your interested
 - 4. Expectations of SME
 - a. 4-day workshop (in person) in Boise in Feb '25
 - b. Attend a 90 min virtual pre-workshop mtg
 - c. Provide initial position information (2-3 hrs) self paced prior to the in-person
 - d. Attend virtual design workshop tentatively set for May/June '25
 - e. Review & provide expert feedback (1-2 hr mtg and up to 15-20 hrs per month self pace and all virtual)
 - f. Assist with final edits and test course evaluation
 - 5. Lead SME expectations
 - a. Need for a strong commitment and has time
 - b. Communicates project progress and milestones to position steward
 - c. Assist in adjudicating SME review comments & feedback
 - 6. Chris asked about membership on committee and also serving as a SME?
 - a. David: if members available to be an SME then that is great, has worked different ways

 - 1. SME group selected by end of Oct
 - 2. Analysis due around Feb
 - 3. April/May steward committee briefing
