3. Curriculum

- NWCG asked where LAL and Haines were listed in behavior course curriculum
- b. Discussion:
 - i. Mitch:
 - 1. S-190....should be a quick fix online and need tell instructors not to teach to it via a change memo
 - 2. S-290...no Haines or LAL in the new course
 - a. Deleted out terms in the text base FWF forecast

c. S-290

- i. Mitch
 - 1. Joe and Heather put on a new "test" course.
 - a. Got some good feedback.
 - 2. 1st six units thru the review process
 - 3. Last 4 units being reviewed
 - 4. Course coming up in CO
 - a. Mix of 1st six reviewed units and following 4 units (draft)
 - 5. Hope in early Jan to have final edits
 - 6. Heather has found folks to do cool illustrations
 - 7. Trying to pick an official NWCG blessed course for S-290 in Jan/Feb.
 - 8. Hoping to get feedback during initial certified courses (first six months) and make edits as needed.
 - 9. Hope to make annual updates as well.

ii. Chris

- 1. Call with Kevin (NWCG), Heather etc yesterday to discuss updates
- 2. Need to find a test course
- 3. Heather would like to put together a 1-2 hr "How to teach" the class video for the portal since it is a blended course.
 - a. Train the Trainer
- 4. Is March the certification deadline?

5. Chris will ask Kevin if the course doesn't get certified in March can folks still use the material?

iii. Rocco

- 1. 48 students for 2 different sessions (24 students each session)
- 2. Need to get students logged into portal
- 3. 2 days onsite
- 4. Student needs to clear "Info" button to get to next slide (Articulate)
 - a. Should get that cleared up soon
- 5. Comments box added so students can provide feedback

iv. Tami

- 1. Annual updates will help with getting funding each year.
- d. Fire Videos/Fire Wx Handbook (Ryan/Brent)
 - i. 2 videos recorded
 - 1. Introduction to Fire Weather (complete)
 - 2. Heating and Cooling (almost done/few tweaks)
 - ii. Temp and RH relationship script almost done
 - iii. Air movement script being worked on but close to being done
 - iv. Additional ideas for videos include inversions, cold front, stability and plan to pull Mental Model script off shelf and do some revisions
 - v. Samantha producing videos/animations and getting feedback
 - vi. Darren has been busy as of late so no updates on the handbook.
- e. Ring O Rang- Knowledge as a Service (KAS) Chris
 - i. Talked to Dave Schultz (NWCG liaison) wondering if WFIT is an option on how to move forward (ie get approval etc).
 - 1. Need to know whether Ring O Rang use can proceed otherwise all of the other work is for not.

ii. Mitch:

- 1. Ring O Rang is really cool.
- 2. There is a front-loaded effort to get questions set-up for each course.
- 3. Hope to continue to use it for S-290
- 4. Does Implementation go to GATR and course lead?

iii. Dan:

- 1. Current contract was tough to push through....it was picked up by an East Coast team so was tougher to work through.
 - a. Delayed start of contract 6 months
 - b. Current agreement runs through March 2024.
- 2. Suggests let current contract run its course then do a new one.
- 3. Dan talked to Robert at KAS....their development team is not spending as much time because of SME's/Mitch good work

- a. Thus, excess of \$30,000 dollars available
- b. Idea for stand alone app (NWCG or USFS) that could make things more manageable (IT) down the road.
- 4. Didn't address whether need more licensing.
- Decision that needs to be made...use \$\$\$ to add more licensing or create a more concise App or perhaps do both
- 6. Dan put in proposal for IAWF conference (Boise) after our face to face and it got accepted.
 - a. Robert/Dan will present
- 7. Tami: Wildfire Magazine hungry for articles so tossed that idea out about the blended learning approach Fire Env has adopted plus use of Ring O Rang for adult education
 - a. Highlight we are trying to teach differently to get student's head around the Fire Environment subject

f. S-390 (Chris)

- i. Kick off meeting in Moscow January 16-18
- ii. Matt will lead that effort with Mitch's help
- iii. Looking to hire a few more SME's so this doesn't turn into a full time job
- iv. Possible people:
 - 1. John Saltenberger (plans to retire in May)
 - 2. Chuck Mchugh plans to retire this year

g. S-490/590 (Chris)

- i. Was at 590 steering committee mtg last week
- ii. 37 students will go to course
- iii. Many students didn't meet pre-req including S-495 and other items due to fire season
- iv. Tonja:
 - 1. Went to mtg Dennis put together
 - 2. Two S-490 courses being taught during week of April 8th
 - a. CA
 - b. Great Basin
 - 3. Latest Behave may not get released in time

v. Nicole:

- 1. PNW group will meet and discuss teaching course in perhaps 2025
- h. International Workshop/Continuing Ed (Tami)
 - i. Canadians interested in this
 - ii. Leverage IAWF to deal with logistics on back-end
 - iii. Formulate a plan in terms of requirements for refresher due to changing science etc
 - 1. FBS, Fire Env?
 - 2. Probably not each year

- i. Statement of work for S-390/490
 - i. Annie...forwarded to us because
 - ii. Large Contract (U of I):
 - 1. \$200,000 or 390
 - 2. \$200,000 for 490
 - iii. Try to use some of the \$\$\$ for SME development which would make it easier

4. Budget Fiscal Year 2024 (Tami)

- a. Ready to implement \$180,000 for U of I and need to decide *where* to push the \$20,000 for future FBFRG/pocket guide updates
- b. Current UAF agreement
 - i. Negatives:
 - 1. Tami is only one on sub-committee that can manage this contract right now but Dan could take that on.
 - a. WO FAM
 - 2. They pay less per hour
 - ii. Positives:
 - 1. Unique consortia with good commo with Canadians and CFDRS
 - iii. \$17,000 left for UAF (5 yr agreement, in place for 1 year)
- c. So, we have a decision:
 - i. Push additional \$\$\$ to UAF or push \$20k to U of I
 - ii. Group decided to move \$20,000 to U of I
- d. \$100,000 will go to Ring O Rang
 - i. Dan: probably too much \$\$ unless we go down the S-390 route
 - ii. Per another convo Tami had....Heather thinks that Ring O Rang could be used for a S-390 refresher (pre-course set of modules) vs use for S-390

5. Budget Fiscal Year 2025 (Chris)

- a. Due Jan 5th
- b. Thought was to request another \$200,000 for U of I
- c. Dan
 - suggests we ask for \$100,000 for KAS and more \$\$\$ for video development
- d. Mann Gulch?
 - i. Tami: good with current sole source contract
 - ii. Kyle:
 - Patrick (chair) good with hosting material/video on leadership toolbox
 - 2. In order, to get an official Staff Ride...need to have all 3 phases represented including integration.
 - iii. Do we wait and see how field responds to the videos or should we try to fund another development idea?

iv. Group decided to request funding for another project
