- 1. <u>Participants:</u> Tonja, Nick, Chris, David Schultz, Rocco, Mitch, Kevin, Nate, Joe flores, Cheryl, Andrew, Dan, Nicole, Matt, David Greathouse, Steven Stolze
- 2. <u>Introductions to Joe Flores:</u>
 - a. He will be attending our monthly meetings due to IPTM process
 - b. Kevin Maier NWCG retiring soon and Brian Holmes taking over curriculum Liasson.
- 3. IPTM FBAN/LTAN Process (multiple people)
 - a. Outstanding questions going forward
 - i. Division requirement still needed?
 - 1. In past, discussion about combining LTAN/FBAN position
 - ii. Can lead instructor be LTAN qualified?
 - b. Comments:
 - David Schultz: this round of IPTM and schedule for FBAN/LTAN is pretty tight contractually
 - 1. Getting position description and creating the new standards
 - 2. Contract to set up to be done by July 2025
 - 3. Some of the changes just mentioned won't necessarily get completed by IPTM process due to contract timeline
 - a. Certainly, those things can be talked about in the analysis process and during the SME workshop
 - b. Will need to document and keep track of those needs
 - c. Will ultimately need to be changed through the formal NWCG request for change process (RFC)
 - 4. Will be short turn around times to get comments back so be flexible with your schedule
 - ii. Chris: we want a larger group (not just FBS) to discuss those outstanding questions
 - iii. Kevin Maier: once inventory those 2 positions during IPTM process and contract closes out can use IPTM products/assessments to help direct where we go
 - 1. IPTM won't resolve the issues/questions but help direct future change requests via recommendations
 - 2. Long term Goal: findings perhaps lead having a singular fire analyst position
 - 3. Near term Goal: FBAN/LTAN positions lined out in an IPTM style
- 4. Increase AD Rate (Chris)
 - a. Email sent out during holiday period

- b. Q & A/comments
 - i. Nick asked Dave about the "Pause" memo for NWCG changes
 - 1. Dave: Lots of discussion about AD rates for other groups too
 - a. NWCG doesn't determine AD rates the agencies do
 - Incident Business Committee (IBC) webpage has some information/guidance on how to walk thru the process for adjusting AD rates
 - c. IBC will take the info and look at IPD then send off to the departments
 - i. IBC is basically part of the pass thru process
 - d. Departments do all of the leveling and make decisions on the rates
 - ii. Tonja: read the doc and thought content was good, may need a date
 - iii. Matt:
 - 1. not every FBAN supports a CIMT
 - 2. FBAN's have had to step up due to ISAP process
- 5. <u>Curriculum</u> (multiple)
 - a. S-290 (Mitch)
 - i. Not a lot of updates
 - ii. In NWCG hands for certification
 - iii. Comments:
 - 1. Kevin: pdf containing a list of issues sent this morning from NWCG publications to Heather's group
 - a. Mostly grammatical
 - i. Weird cap
 - b. Course will have to go thru w/o Key Terms and Questions (KT & Q) and Notes part that was initially blessed but publications doesn't have a template for it
 - i. Doesn't fit in their NWCG system/compatibility/how they streamline courses
 - ii. KT & Q is a pre-worksheet for students
 - iii. So, need to re-record Unit 0
 - 2. Rocco: used the new shell of it last week for 2 classes and well received by the students
 - a. Action: Will write up thoughts about the success of KT & Q during those classes
 - iv. KAAS (Dan)
 - 1. No updates
 - 2. KAS has access to the latest shell in the Learning Portal so will be updating their material
 - b. S-390 (Matt)

- i. Moving right along
- ii. Online training is out for review
- iii. Contractor turned over Units to NWCG so currently in a review process as of yesterday morning
- iv. Matt says they already know they need to tweak a couple of units
- v. On track for March test course in Great Basin (Boise)
- vi. Joe Hernandez going to use the shell for teaching the course in SW but won't be a test course
 - 1. He is setting it up in the Learning Portal
- vii. Using a different process to do the course compared to S-290
 - 1. S-390 contractor is much more versed in IPTM process and dealing with the bureaucracy
- viii. Comments
 - 1. Kevin:
 - a. S-390 draft course done by the end of Jan
 - b. David G can use the new version in June as a test course but won't be certified by then
 - 2. Rocco:
 - a. Will be using some version of the new course in Feb
 - b. Shell should be in the portal today sometime
 - 3. Chris: how do people get the updated class?
 - a. Kevin: Once they run the test course (assuming no major issues) in March then test course can be used for future teaching from NWCG
- c. S-490 (Tonja)
 - i. Contractor (Soft-tech) sent out Training Design Plan Dec 31st to SME's
 - 1. Tonja: Who blesses the design plan?
 - a. Kevin said NWCG will bless it
 - ii. Most of the work has been on the Training Design Plan
 - Lots of comments on it and meeting done to deal with those issues
 - iii. Once plan ok then NWCG will go into development
- d. Mann Gulch/RT-130 (Dan)
 - i. Nothing additional
- 6. Budget 2026 (Chris)
 - a. Wind Reduction factors (Dan)
 - i. \$150,000
 - ii. Missoula Lab
 - iii. Came out of convo with Technosylva
 - 1. Wind reduction factors don't see as refined as they could be

- Need to collect high-res data using lab wind tunnels and place high resolution sensors/towers in different land feature locations in an experimental forest
- 3. \$\$\$ towards setting up array and developing a sensor array
 - a. 50k towards instrumentation
 - b. 50k towards the contactor to design and build
- b. Mitch's position (Chris)
 - i. May get turned down due to labor
 - ii. 15k every 2 years to help maintain publications
- c. Comments:
 - i. Nick: what is the line between salary vs not salary (fed vs SME)?
 - 1. David: Unsure can give a clear answer, this transition occurred when he just got in
 - a. \$\$\$ put towards completing a product
 - b. Not super clear
 - c. Document concerns and can put forward
- 7. Spring Mtg (Brent)
 - a. Week of May 5th
 - b. No real updates
 - c. Haven't receiving a key email so plan to submit a request to Omna (formalized Staff Ride) to get a quote
 - d. Need approximate attendance number
- 8. <u>Hosting Fire Behavior Refresher</u> (Tonja)
 - a. Help teach or refresh skills or new skills
 - i. Good for collaboration and refresher
 - ii. Nextgen, Behave 7, case studies
 - iii. Not re-create S-495 so some baseline knowledge needed
 - b. Reached out to Lawen (Region 1) to see if they wanted to collaborate
 - c. Billy Phillips does annual risk training
 - i. Nice layout for training
 - d. Erin Noonan RMA also interested
 - e. Considering a Fire Behavior track mimicking what Billy Phillips has done
 - f. Hope it aligns well with the committee
 - i. Inter-agency collab effort
 - g. Comments
 - i. Matt: they did this in the past (fire behavior workshop) including discuss case studies, present new research from the Lab etc, great idea
 - 1. Really good if can broadcast to multiple regions
 - 2. Great for unit folks
 - 3. Usually kept it to 1 to 1.5 days

- a. LFM database up and running in FEMS
- b. Need to emphasize standards
 - i. Units should do it every 2 weeks and enter the data
 - ii. When fire season gets busy that falls off
- c. Who should champion this within Fire Env?
 - i. Nick thought FBS would be best suited for this
- d. Comments
 - i. Cheryl: there is no designated steward for fuel moistures
 - 1. Learned this from FEMS development
 - 2. Therefore there are no standards (aka sampling process etc)
