### Meeting Agenda: FDSC Objectives/Standards

Cheryl working on committee subgroup template for FDSC.

The overall mission for FDSC did not change, but the primary objectives have, and the subcommittee is looking for FENC approval.

Fire danger rating definition is still being discussed and will be submitted when changes are decided upon.

Once approved, FDSC objectives can be posted on NWCG website.

FENC supports and approves.

SOP also has an agency roster rotation that they are starting to apply starting with NASF and NPS. Vice-chair was vacant but has been filled along with all positions after switching to the rotation concept. Looking at pulling in an Eastern rep from NASF.

Continuing with 2-year agency rotation as well as keeping FENC guidelines for a blended roster function.

## **Chair Update**

PSOG presented the LTP 14 concepts at the NWCG/NMAC/FMB joint

meeting. The concepts were split into 3 larger "buckets."

What does fire environment support services look like with a focus on predictive services.

Fire environment centers were supported and FMB took back that tasking as it's being worked on already by more elevated programs.

Fire environment monitoring and prediction services on IT and science side was the second bucket and was highly supported.

FMB would like PSOG to work on options and scalability for bucket 2.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> bucket was almost solely regarding predictive services and was supported by FMB who decided that they would like national program moving forward. The program should be a top to bottom program, but they would like options for what that looks like.

How are we looking regarding obligation and expenditure of funding for this

FY? Need to track at some point to see if agreements need to be put in place.

Fire weather doesn't have anything that will need this.

Projects funded for FY23: all from fire behavior.

Mod for Naffri agreement is part of it. \$80,000

Have proposed several rotations for FENC but have had a hard time finding one that will work for Fire Environment group. -Request Cheryl to report back what works for FDSC.

DRI recently published a journal paper using NOAA Sea Star grants on Red Flag Warning criteria and a new matrix. This can be used as a launching point for utilizing the criteria over in a fire weather test bed. The percentile data will yield different numbers for each area, but it should ultimately be consistent across the nation.

Will announce awarded contractor for IPTM efforts in a couple of weeks.

Training coordinator at Naffri has very few people enrolled has created a placeholder for 490 in April 2024 if the decision is to have it.

495 is currently being taught by some great instructors and has initiated discussion regarding the next scheduled class and any needed updates.

Include Katie O'Hara in correspondence regarding course changes to make sure that there are no NWCG concerns and the personnel is available for the update efforts as ITPM is the main concern.

NWCG did get approval to hire additional training specialists.

CA wildfire coordinating group formed PS subcommittee and working with NOPs and SOPs PS units on project to create critical wind reference sheet for the entire state. Numerical rating system.
