Discussed new weather program.

- 1. Demonstrated observations of data.
- 2. Demonstrated message data.
- 3. Demonstrated both Google Earth buttons.
- 4. Showed what the raw message data page will look like.
- 5. Discussed the Last Maintenance Date display. Will go to a yellow background with white lettering when the station is at or within 44 days past due. Will go to a red background with white letters when the station is over 45 days past due.
- 6. Discussed the amount of data being stored.

Discussed the lightning program.

- 1. Wanting the option of viewing the data from the vendor, dependent on cost.
- 2. The vendor would send the data to WRCC for archive.
- 3. The vendor would store 18 months of data for retrieval.
- 4. Looking into a portal from Boise to the vendor for IT security purposes.

Discussed Intellisense portable station.

- 1. Sending Jesse Gray and Kip Watson to their factory this month to observe their calibration methods to confirm they meet NFDRS.
- 2. Report should be complete in January.
- 3. Discussed that the system uses Iridium to transmit data.
- 4. Iridium can be ingested in the LRGS.
- 5. Discussed the feasibility of using Iridium. DOD and DOI have a contract with Iridium.

Discussed visit with Ott and FTS at RSFWSU.

- 1. Both are looking at adding Iridium as a secondary telemetry source
- 2. This would allow for collection of data and interaction with the data logger remotely.
- 3. Ott has the ability to access their data logger with Bluetooth and a mobile app.
