### Old Business

Zach – P310/410 Request for Change (RFC) update: The request was approved, and the requirement will take effect soon. Persons who are already qualified will not be required to take the training to maintain the qualification but will be encouraged to attend if possible. Trainees and people opening new taskbooks will be required to take the training before their taskbook can be recommended for certification.

A discussion about making P410 a requirement next year for the National FPET Schedule was had and the group decided to table the discussion for next meeting. We will do a IQCS report to see how many federal responders would be affected by this. Also, a survey for the webinar could be used to capture the non-fed folks.

### New Business
