1) RXB1/RXB2 Tasking

a) Any updates? Task book is done, out for testing. Please provide feedback on round two. please review the codes and tasks. Trainees will be providing feedback as well as evaluators.

5/19/2023 Update: Course is done and will be implemented October of this year. Course material is all set to go. S390 is adding into prework so it may be removed from RX300. Same Prework for both S390 and RX300.

2) RT-300 Video Rx Burn Plan Technical Review

Update from 6/15/23 – Casey and Chuck presented to FMC. No major feedback.

Chuck met with CO and contractor and two from NWCG to meet and greet (6/14/23). Went over timeline and needs, SOW, and deliverables. File sharing site will be set up, then Chuck will reach out to get the working group going on script (developing images and language), story board development. Chuck will be primary POC. Want to focus on tech reviews and tie to formal course materials. General discussion on tech reviews and content to include (lesson learned through escape reviews, etc.). May

<u>Action item:</u> Past videos, marketing is a problem. Difficult to find and hampering use. Need to make more accessible, make for usable.
