FELB Training: (Guarino) Report from Lead SME. Dan Staab is our NWCG Training Unit lead.

- Need to discuss this more from last meeting. Think about FELB Vs HEQB. Do we need to know how to run a dozer or feller buncher to be HEQB?
- IPSC BLM wants to require new S-212 level, currently or previously a FAL2 to be FELB committee agree or disagree?

Notes: Berkebile is good with just having S-112 as the prerequisite for S-112. Mack is good with just S112 training, Guarino good with S-112 training, Ben can go either way. Logan is good with S112 training wanting to add strong communication between the felling team and adjoining resources, maintain cutting area control in the PTB. Bruington is good with S-112. Report out:

USFS Chainsaw Program (Mclaughlin): Done with detail

USFS Climbing Program (Winn): Program is back certifying instructors in non-USFS agencies. Thanks to Aaron for sharing saw program policies in this arena on who has responsibilities for that. This will help program a lot. Large numbers of climbers went through training across the country this year for climber and instructor certifications. Training continues to be in demand.

Very big demand for cone collection climbing this season across multiple regions. Still happening now. We called out climbers from across the country to help in Idaho and Oregon for the larger efforts this year.

EC-4, our specialized climbing course with advanced chainsaw use is in demand. Several classes for certification occurred in OR, CA this year. Travel costs are impacting some folks' ability to get there. We are having more discussions about appropriate instructors for this (industry professional v. in house), as it has been industry professionals. Costs can be high and may limit who can get this in the future.

NTDP (Apuzzo): European helmets are passing the NFPA 1977 tests, will know more soon. Adapting chaps to more form fitting.

BLM: FALV is moving forward. IM draft has been edited and waiting for approval. FALV will be in IQCS. BL312 to get FALV T and RT312 to get FALV recertification annually.

FWS: Don't have one

BIA: Not on the Call
