- **NWCG Airtanker Base Directory / Directory App**
 - The Directory App does not have a specific date on when it will be ready.
 - Working through changes with NWCG and unsure on the timing of completion.

- **Standards for Airtanker Base Operations Unit (SABO)**
 - Comments from the IABS website have been coming in. The comments will be evaluated and considered for the 2021 SABO.

- **Airtanker Base Training and Qualifications Unit (ABTQU)**
 - The ABTQU has been tasked with looking into the AD Pay Scale for the various airtanker base positions. The Unit will provide recommendations to the IABS and the IABS will pass on to NIAC for consideration.
