- **NWCG Airtanker Base Directory / Directory App**
  - An email was sent out asking each base to ensure their information is updated/accurate.
  - There has been discussion about the ramp frequencies. They can be found in the Directory App but are not included when individual base pages are selected. This is due to their sensitive nature. The Directory Unit is working with the developers to have the ramp frequency added to each bases section, but it will not come out when printed.
- **Standards for Airtanker Base Operations Unit (SABO)**
  - There are a few updates to the recently completed 2022 SABO. These have been released and are updated on the NWCG website.
- **Airtanker Base Training and Qualifications Unit (ABTQU)**
  - The ABTQU has been tasked with identifying a location for the bi-annual National Airtanker Base Manager Workshop. Once the unit has recommended a location it will be elevated by the IABS Chair for approval.
  - Tentative date: the week of November 14th, 2022.
  - A call letter has been sent out with a survey for people to supply feedback.
- **Airtanker Base Operational Risk Management Unit (ABORMU)**
  - The Unit is working with Donna Shope to look at a variety of checklists for airtanker bases to use as a part of SMS.
  - The checklists will be managed through PRISM SMS Solutions.

- **SEAT Unit**

- The Unit has been tasked with creating a how-to type of document on the necessary reporting information when managing SEATs. A draft has been completed and will be sent to the IABS for review shortly.
