    - Delete: "notes" at the bottom, sunrise and sunset are determined by the official sunrise/sunset tables of the nearest reload base.
    - Will work with NAFRI to update the table.
      - All voting members concur.
    - Will fill out a change request form (supplement 505n)
  - Flights of Multi Engine Water Scoopers
    - Do we want to include the scoopers in the "flight" category, or leave as just SEATS and Fire bosses?
    - Need to modify the flights section with the TFR/FTA verbiage.

# Interagency Aerial Supervision Subcommittee

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- Need to clarify the CalFire section regarding flights of S2's in the FTA.
  - Recommend deleting the CalFire section of the flights in the FTA.
- Need to review and compare the PMS 505 and PMS 518 requirements.
- Will review and discuss further next month.
- Approval of Chapter 3 Table 1 Aerial Supervision Requirements Table (update)
  - It has been verbally approved by NIAC, still waiting for documentation.
- SAS Pg 6 Row 21 & 32.
  - “note: USFS and Department of the Interior (DOI) employees must attend and pass the National Aerial Supervision Training Course or the California Aerial Supervision Course.”  
Change to:
  - “**Note:** USFS and Department of the Interior (DOI) employees must attend and pass the National Aerial Supervision Training Course or the California Aerial Supervision Course **before performing OJT as an ATGS/HLCO.**”
- LPIL Change requests.
  - Will forward the requests to LPIL vice-chair and will work with NASSU leadership to review and get concurrence with the working groups.
  - Will be discussed at the next Lead plane meeting.
  - Reminder: these changes will NOT be effective for the 2023 season. Proposed changes once reviewed and elevated from NASSU to IASS will be submitted for the 2024 SAS updates.
