The IFPC facilitates collaborative fire management planning at local, state, regional, tribal, and national levels to support coordinated and consistent interagency fire management efforts across jurisdictional boundaries. Primary objectives include:
- Promote integrated federal fire management planning and communication across NWCG agencies and related to the National Cohesive Wildland Fire Management Strategy (Cohesive Strategy).
- Communicate individual agency planning efforts and policy changes within IFPC and across NWCG agencies..
- Maintain standards for Resource Advisors.
- Provide fire planning training content in support of common and agency specific standards and policies.
