 - The NIFS received a significant symbology update. This update standardizes symbology by functional area, improves readability of symbols on mobile devices and printed products.
 - Update description paper
- Wildland Fire Location and Perimeter Datasets
 - The 2020 fire season saw a huge public demand for fire location and fire perimeter datasets.
 The public perimeter dataset alone received almost 3 Billion hits from users.
