1. READ SC Updates – Linn Gassaway and Tim Kramer

- Submitted almost all drafts to subcommittee and received comments. Looking to have IFPC review after May 23 with 2 week turn around.
- Contacted naming committee; READ, REAF, and ARCH already assigned. Looking to see if Lead READ will be standalone or under all hazard. Lead READ would have additional requirements if under all hazard.
- Proposed acronym LRED, waiting to see what naming committee comes up with.
- Looking into how LOFR READ can be used.
- Currently all four positions have:
 - o IPD
 - \circ Training
 - Taskbook
- Still needed:
 - Transition plan (put it all in one for all the positions) *Can be reviewed by IFPC*. Draft can be included with rest of package.
 - Transition plan examples: <u>IPSC Correspondence</u>
 - IFPC will set up channel for review of the package.
- <u>Repair Plan:</u>
 - Working to coordinate input with the working group looking to publish the "repair guide" prior to it being published. Subcommittee would like to provide comments and have them included.
 - Justin- "ARCH mentions one of the requirements is to "adhere to suppression damage plan..." Is that something to take out or leave in for now?
 - Linn- the guide written is more about providing the number of repair options that can be used by those writing the repair plan (A composition of BMP type options).

2. Development of Fire Planner/Analyst Curriculum – Laura Barrett

- Kick off meeting was Friday to talk about what training curriculum for fire planning/analyst would look like.
 - Using existing online content
 - Module concept training (self-paced)
 - Creating new online content

- Likely a need for in person/academy type skill set training
- Project/testing?
- Looking at timeframe (winter might work best)
- Look at the pathways that people come from to fire planning/analyst to highlight skill sets and build on the gaps.
- GOALS
 - o Identify additional opportunities for on-the-job training/learning
 - RMA/WFDSS support opportunities
 - IMT/Incident Management Positions (LTAN/FBAN/SOPL)
 - o Identify course work based on necessary skills for fire planners/analysts
 - Looking at forest/regional level position skills
- Next step- get with fire planners to outline skill sets and training that would lead to the fire planner competencies/skills
- Action item before next call: Poll agency planners to come up with list of duties/competencies that a fire planner needs/does.
