## **Agenda Topics:**

1. IPD Update – Continue to review OPS IPDs and provide feedback through the feedback button on-line.
2. Committee APPROVED the changes on the IPD for HEQB – Mike Black was on and received the verbal OK  
Please review the current IPD statements that we edited and let us know if captures the feedback.
  - CURRENT IPD STATEMENT #1-Ensure assigned equipment and transport travel to and from the fireline safely.
    - NEW W/ FEEDBACK- Manage and maintain accountability of service/support vehicles, transport and personnel during incident travel; adequate ingress/egress, bridge load limits, turnarounds, safety zones, parking, etc.
  - CURRENT IPD STATEMENT #2-Ensure operator follows safe loading/unloading and mounting/dismounting procedures and parks equipment and transport in secure area.
    - NEW W/ FEEDBACK- Ensure operator follows safe loading/unloading and mounting/dismounting procedures and parks service/support vehicles and transport in secure area.
3. S-215 Suggestion on tactics and terminology:
  - a. Committee did not see the need to adopt or push forward the suggestion. Chair will respond to the individual and emphasize the latitude to adjust the training to fit the needs of the local unit while retaining the overall objectives. S courses cannot be created to accommodate the unique aspects of all local units, thus instructors have the flexibility to make the course relevant to a local entity.
4. S-130 Rewrite – Erin Burkhammer
  - a. Continue to look at website and provide feedback. <https://www.nwcg.gov/publications/training-courses>
  - b. S-130 will be a template and all class material will be housed on the website.
  - c. Potential for L-180 to become separate content from S130 – Burkhammer will keep us posted on progress.
5. Review the current PMS 210 and be prepared for a survey regarding its relevance. OTC will roll out survey soon.
  - a. Consider how to consolidate Position Standards to support IPDs, or the creation of an OPS Guide to replace ops related content in the PMS 210. Look at old PMS 462 “Tactics Guide” as an idea for standards. The PMS 462 is no longer in use but may provide as some assistance. Link to PMS 462:
