- Committee feels that allowing a 10 person module to count is not an equivalent experience to supervising a 16-21 person crew. The full crew (16-21) is regarded as VERY IMPORTANT and should not be removed. This brings into question the appropriateness of the SMJ exemption.
- Creating a "Module" Boss was discussed but concerns were raised over unforeseen negative outcomes of this approach.
- Next Step: Respond to IPSC with above view and ask for more information AND look at <u>REMOVING</u> the SMJ exemption from the PTB.
- Once we get feedback from IPSC and then this committee of the direction this topic heads, we will respond to the submitter.
