5	Safety Zone Calculation Change	RFC 2023- 04	Marlene Eno- Hendren/Daniel Jimenez	<ul> <li>Dan Jimenez from the Rocky Mountain Research Station presented Safety Zone background, research, and reasons asking for the change in Safety Zone calculations.</li> <li>Risk Management Committee (RMC) and Fire Environment Committee (FENC) have been presented the same briefing and support moving forward.</li> <li>Lengthy discussion occurred around the time needed to properly vet this and the extent to different applications and systems this change would reach.</li> <li>Marlene spoke with IOSC, they will focus on the IRPG updates when the time comes.</li> <li>Marlene will work with RMC &amp; FENC to draft a communication document to address what this means to the field and be used for further vetting.</li> </ul>	n SC accepied the RPC.
6	RX-301/341 Consolidation and Course Number		Colby Jackson	<ul> <li>Recommendation from the contractor working with the Fire Management Committee in updating these courses, is to combine RX-301/341 into one course as it was in the past. This is due in part to the courses being taught in conjunction with each other and how the curriculum is intertwined throughout the training session.</li> <li>Suggested using the old course number RX-300.</li> <li>NWCG Training will draft a briefing paper to give to IPSC.</li> </ul>	
7	310-1 COML Required Position Change – Request to Withdraw RFC	RFC 2022- 08	Travis Bailey	<ul> <li>After the RFC was approved to change the COML qualification requirement, ILSC received an abundant amount of feedback with opposition to the change.</li> <li>ILSC will discuss the option to keep the requirement for a year as a pilot.</li> <li>If the decision is made to submit a new RFC to withdraw the change, ILSC will need to address a transition plan for the resources that opened a COML PTB after the change went into effect.</li> </ul>	ILSC will discuss further before bringing this back to IPSC.

8	UASP Qualification Requirement Change	RFC 2022- 11	Mike Black/ Craig Daughtery/ Sarah Saarloos/ Joe Sean. Kennedy	<ul> <li>IPSC reviewed the proposed transition plan, PMS 310-1 language, and UASP qualification sheet.</li> <li>S-373 course will now be required before opening a PTB.</li> <li>PMS 310-1 will be updated immediately with the proposed language.</li> <li>Mike Black will draft a memo and send to Marlene.</li> </ul>	IPSC voted to accept the proposed changes.
9	CIM Tasking Update	2021-08	Marlene Eno- Hendren	<ul> <li>Executive Board approved the mid and long-term transition plans.</li> <li>Mid-term plan effective date was rolled back to January 2024.</li> <li>The Type 2 to CIM path with the field evaluation will remain effective until January 2025.</li> <li>Long-term plan <ul> <li>NWCG Training will work with IPSC for a course steering committee to work on Basic and Advanced IMT training.</li> <li>Marlene empathized the importance of those working on the steering committee and SMEs be committed and available to do the work.</li> <li>NWCG Training Program will reprioritize for the Basic IMT training to be completed by December 2024, and Advanced IMT training completed by December 2025, with implementation January 2026.</li> <li>Position specific training will also be reprioritized in the NWCG Training Program.</li> <li>Training will need to be completed prior opening a PTB for Type 3 or Unit Leader moving to CIM.</li> <li>Expecting a tasking from the Executive Board in the near term.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Discussed if S-420 and L-481 courses would go away after Basic and Advanced IMT training is completed. Dave Celino reported this topic was discussed at the State Fire Supervisors meeting and the States felt it was important to keep S-420 in the pathway of training. Continued discussion will occur as the steering committee develops Basic and Advance IMT training.</li> <li>IPSC tasked IOSC and ILSC to look at their respective Branch Director positions. Subcommittees will present initial briefing at the March meeting, with a final decision by the Spring in person meeting in April.</li> <li>Forest Service asked for clarification on if a CIM trainee is out with a Type 2 IMT that does not have a CIM qualified, can a Type 2 qualified sign as an evaluator. Further discussion needed.</li> </ul>
