## **NWCG EXECUTIVE BOARD / UPDATES**

- Leadership levels have been added to website, and validated. Leadership Levels on Incident Position Descriptions (IPD's) have been approved by executive board.
- Missing in person LC meetings has not slowed progress and curriculum maintenance, I.E. Leadership Levels.

# L-180/L-280

- L-180 Update:
  - Taking it out of S-130/190, and having it a standalone course.
  - Course has been mostly completed through online delivery.
  - Waiting for Yellow Book updates before moving forward.
  - Need to convert course to Spanish.
- L-280 Update:
  - One slide in "Command Presence" has been changed.
  - Revisions to course objectives made with the NWCG Training Group have not moved forward.
- Barrier(s):
  - Not meeting as a Committee in person has been a challenge for coordination.
- Plan of Action:
  - o Identify Yellow Book updates, and their impact on course development.

- Support any potential Spanish conversion of L-180.
- Identify where the course is at with NWCG.
- Agreed that the CMUL will meet after the conclusion of this meeting.

#### <u>L-380</u>

## (WILLIAMS/LYNDE)

## • Update:

- Communicating with vendors, and verifying they are rolling out course changes.
- There is desire to stand up a National Cadre for L-380 and L-381, and serious conversations are being had about it.
- Montana Department of Natural Resources (DNR) was provided with course info to deliver L-380.
- Since the last Leadership Committee meeting, the course changes have gone into effect.
- Barrier(s):
  - Funding and trainers are a challenge for the L-380/L-381 academy style training.
- Plan of Action:
  - Continue moving forward with possibility of a L-380/L-381 course in an academy style environment.
  - Bring in more individuals into the conversation regarding the potential of a L-380/L-381 academy style training.

## UPDATE TO GROUP

- With an increase in funding expected, inter agency "academy" style training programs could be created with multi-leadership levels in mind.
- How to become a CMU provider has been added to the leadership curriculum website.

# <u>L-381</u>

#### (BROWN/AKERBERG)

(ELLSWORTH/SHULTZ)

- Update:
  - Jake Akerberg has been added as a CMUL.
  - Jake is the only Federal instructor for L-380, and L-381.
  - Vendors are ready for the changes to the curriculum, and are ready to adjust courses.
  - Course is static.
- Barrier(s):
  - o None
- Plan of Action:
  - Coordinate for successional planning for the future.

## <u>L-480</u>

## (SHULTZ/CERDA)

- Update:
  - Curriculum is static, but not stable.

- Updates from 2019 are in the current curriculum, and on the website.
- If the "Qualities" section in the Yellow Book changes, there may be course updates.
- Barrier(s):
  - Providers for the course are a challenge.
- Plan of Action:
  - Continue to reach out to providers and additional vendors for delivery.
  - Agency instructors will be explored, as well as psychologist credentials.

#### <u>L-481</u>

#### (RISKO)

- Update:
  - Shane has retired.
  - One current vendor (MCS).
  - The course is static, but stable.
  - In discussions with an additional vendor for course delivery.
- Barrier(s):
  - Vendors were in their busy season when asking for delivery options.
  - Connection of L-481, and S-420.
- Plan of Action:
  - Continue looking for new course vendors.
  - An additional person as a L-481 CMUL is necessary.

## <u>L-580</u>

#### (Ellsworth)

- Update:
  - 2 deliveries of the course this fall (Gettysburg/Chit-Chat).
  - NAFRI delivered these courses.
  - 4 deliveries of the course are scheduled for next year.
- Barrier(s):
  - Many students in the course did not meet the C&G requirements, and intent of the course.
- Plan of Action:
  - Course needs to be defined better in terms of student pre-requisites, and C&G criteria.
  - Re-evaluate original intent of the course as a C&G senior leader course.

## **STAFF RIDES**

- Update:
  - National Staff Ride Development Workshops set up for this winter (January and February).
  - Staff Ride at Mack Lake is being redesigned on the NWCG website and facilitators page.
  - Chit-Chat delivery by SE Forestry was tied into a L-580 course this year.

#### (RISKO)

- $\circ~$  Mixed delivery is a topic for discussion as far as what makes a course an L-580 course.
- Shane Olpin got an invite for a meeting with the Geographic Area Training Representatives (GATRs).
- Discussion to put in for a NWCG budget request for the Staff Ride Development Workshops.
