USFS and BLM – decision to conduct NVG ops should be left to the individual agency to determine if the risk is worth the flying the mission. CalFire – they have control factors in place to determine if the risk is worth the reward. OAS – asked if minimum standards are in place to conduct NVG ops, CalFire relayed that there are minimum standards. USFS – their operations plan covers this, and Firescope is probably the best document to cover this. BIA- believes we will see more requests to conduct night ops. NIAC – thinks FMB should be briefed on this topic so that individual agencies can determine if they want to allow night ops.
