- 1. Incorporation of Community Lifelines (e.g. components, definition, purpose, and stabilization);
- 2. Renewed emphasis on existing and new concepts (e.g. private sector integration and cross-sector coordination); and
- 3. Reorganization and general streamlining of legacy content (e.g. new sections).
