### **Beginning Discussion**

- General updates:
- Revisit- NIMS Alert: 41-19 Community Lifelines Toolkit 2.0; expect this to remain as a method to organize information and reporting.
- Revisit- Using the Resource Typing Library Tool (RTLT): possible overview from our FEMA NIC
  colleagues; summary of how the process works from Hank. Can be swift or extended depending
  on how many stakeholders are affected by a change.
- Revisit- NIMS-IC is now the Parent of the PMS 200: NWCG Standards for Wildland Fire Resource Typing; standards for heavy equipment have been recently updated, expect the standards for aircraft to be updated soon.

## Assignments and Updates

- Update of the NQS by SME groups; has anyone made progress with the FEMA NIC effort? Heard a little from the PIO Subcommittee Chair who is involved with this effort; he has recommended that the PIO Type 4 be established; Logistics SME group met and found there to be potential conflict regarding fitness standards; Liaison Officer Group met and found very few conflicts.
- NWCG All Chairs; updated audience on the work of our committee. Mentioned both the FEMA NIC assistance and the Endorsements process.
- Volunteer to attend one of the webinars associated with NIMS Alert 03-20; Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) Doctrine. *Still need a volunteer*.

#### Follow-on discussion

- WFCA Wildfire Initiative- update from Ken Kehmna; looking for contributors to assist with the incident workforce succession planning problem as it concerns western fire chiefs association.
- Type 3 IMT Tiered System; concept paper has received not outright resistance, look for development of a standard for implementation in the next few months. Jeff Soule is presenting the concept to several groups over the next couple months.
- Proposals for where and when we could meet face-to-face; possible activity to organize around. *Idea to make the next face-to-face concurrent with the AH-IMT-A Symposium.*
