1. NWCG Update

- PIOSC work for CIMT transition has been an incredible lift and is much appreciated
- Pushed back the date for the deliverable for the framework for a national level fire restrictions website that will be due in December.
- We had a vote to adopt WPSAPS fire prevention piece of wildland fire management. They're developing a mobile platform for this.
- FPET has been going out on assignments

New Business:

- 1. DOI has approved use of PIO3 position code but will need time to change it in the system.
- 2. PIO3 task book and position description is being discussed in IPSC
- 3. Next month is the change over for new PIOSC officers
 - Chris Barth is nominated as chair
 - Kerry Greene is nominated as vice chair
 - Candice Stevenson will become note-taker.

4. CIMT discussion

- Tasking was issued to IPSC and we should see a request soon
- We will need to discuss transition for PIO1 and PIO2 positions
- Full implementation is planned for next spring
- PIOSC has concerns for type 3 qualified PIO moving to complex PIO, we will look into further training requirements needed to make this transition

- We will consider adding unit leader type positions for type 2 PIOs that do not want to become Complex PIOs
- The focus on updated training will be the most important piece to ensure the success of PIOs to reach the experience and level they desire.
