#### NWCG Updates (Tim Blake)

#### **Executive Board**

- Kudos to Colby Jackson for stepping up when Tim is not available to provide the NWCG updates.
- Aviation Risk Management Subcommittee is officially under National Interagency Aviation Committee (NIAC).
- Fire Chemical Subcommittee has been stood up under Equipment Technology Committee.

- Lead Plane Unit has been stood up under NIAC
- Working with Hazard Tree Subcommittee (HTSC) to work on safety action plan in Brian Hughes fatality.
- Mental Health Subcommittee is moving forward with Miranda Stuart leading.
- 6 Minutes For Safety is doing great work with Kathy Komatz's vision.
- Incident Emergency Medical Subcommittee (IEMS) is doing great work under Kaili McCray's leadership.

# **NWCG Training**

- Incident Position Description: Medical Unit Leader (MEDL) is being reworked under the IEMS.
- The Safety Officer (SOF) positions will need to be examined to proceed with the Incident Position Descriptions. There are a number of individuals identified as SME's.
  - Forward potential SME names to Colby
- Smoke Committee has approved request to make video identifying smoke hazards. Awareness video with a focus on what SOF and MEDL.
- CAL Fire tanker drop video. Released in a week or two. Will be posted on the Cal Fire YouTube site.
- Inquiry on HTSC video production at Wildland Fire Safety Training Annual Refresher (WFSTAR).

## Preparedness Guide for Firefighters & Families

- Decision has been made that the NWCG Executive Board will house this document.
  - Exec Board will draft tasking memorandum to improve the content. Recommend long term stewardship solution.
- Potential task team will be identified to work on revisions.
- Feedback that agency reps on the RMC couldn't be found has been fixed on the RMC roster.

# NTDP Smoke Study Update (George Broyles-Project Lead)

- Three year smoke study in progress.
- Working on S-130/S-190 on course revision to put focus on smoke exposure.
- George had presented recent developments on smoke study to the FS Risk Management Council. Identified cardio vascular disease and lung cancer correlations. Action items included development of multiple new NWCG type products.
  - 4 different products. Includes noise exposure as well as smoke exposure and safety/health consequences. Subject matter experts (NIOSH, IEMS, etc.) will be reviewing applicable information for accuracy.
  - Been working with Kathy Komatz on updated 6MFS.

• Looking at new WFSTAR video production. Steve Holdsambeck will submit official request.

# Columbia River Bar Pilots Video Review (Colby Jackson)

- Mark sent the YouTube links to the Committee for video review.
- Email correspondence to Colby and he will consolidate feedback.
- Next step is to work on facilitator guide.
  - Two volunteers (Tess McCarville and Dave Williams).
  - Intent is to have complete product by Southern US fire season.

- Multiple perspectives on the fatality in South Carolina. Currently counted in the SG.
- BLM has had a few burnover incidents. Documents/FLA/AI forthcoming.
- NPS inquired as to tree strike incidents in AK and SG. Pending any documents/FLA/AI.
  - NMAC notifications- Chad will send to Alex.
- BIA referenced a tree strike and how notifications could influence SG.
- Discussion on criteria reporting. How are the current notifications meeting the intent of the SG? Lessons learned center uses data and reports of accidents/injuries, however all of these may not meet the SG criteria.

**Chad Fisher (NPS)** – Still working on safety position behind Chad. Kudos to Miranda acting in this position. Not sure when the job will be announced. Also working to fill the Lessons Learned Center Director. Coordinating Group advisory chairs have sent a letter to NMAC, originated in the Northern Rockies, regarding heavy equipment bosses. Will be headed to NWCG soon and some discussions to give this to OTC. This should be something the RMC should consider and provide input (i.e. span of control).
