- Looking at electrolytes & food/drink guidance. Will send to RMC to review when complete.
  - o A person's electrolytes show little change pre- to post- shift.
  - o Large fire food contract out for bid. Bumped into food categories for variety.
- Good job with Heat Stress field study. One aspect of the study revealed that the morning hike and pack weight play large part in setting the body's core temperature for the remainder of the day.
- Data collection and analysis of Year 2 of the Firefighter Long Term Health Study is nearing completion.

## Tony Petrilli

- Training update posted on Fire Shelter/PPE website soon.
- Reviewing women firefighter pants for prototypes and testing.
  - Those who responded to survey will be participants—those who did not respond will be given opportunity to via email to be sent in couple of months.
  - New revision of NFPA 1977 PPE requirements for pants is being reviewed.
    - First draft includes a total heat loss test
    - A proposal has been submitted to raise minimum total heat loss value. This change if approved would eliminate the use of nomex-kevlar blend pants. Several members oppose this change due to the need for cold weather ppe in many areas of the country.
- Wildland Firefighting Helmet video will be posted in spring.
