NTDP Update (Petrilli)

- Shelter training update: out next week with some new guidance on how to clean the practice shelters to prevent disease spread.

Line SOF IPD (Goeller)

- Need to revisit this particular IPD. There is significant C&G interaction listed in the IPD that may not be applicable in this position. Big differences between SOF3 and Line Safety (SOFR).
- Request that the agency reps reach out to their SOF1s and SOF2s to solicit their feedback on SOFR duties.

Line SOF IPD (Sean Triplett-FS and Kaili McCray-DOI)

- Kaili was tasked with injury database focus within the Congressionally mandated Dingell Act.
- Working with Sean Triplet at USFS FAMIT.
- DOI will work with SMIS with injury data elements that are required in the DA. The USFS will update the e-Safety system with the same elements. That leaves the States in limbo as to how they would track injuries.
- RMC will be the entity to pull all this info into one report. Direction to provide combined interagency report.
- Sean is the lead for the FS to implement all aspects of the Dingell Act.
- Discussion on whether the NWCG SafetyGram will suffice for reporting criteria.

- FireFit: Can we let this effort fall off because it's so outdated? FireFit is a trademarked name and can no longer be used.
