Discussion/Considerations:

Decision: Available for agencies to use for a training tool.

Topic: INTM to INVL Transition Plan

Presenter: Mike Black and Jerry Hepler

Discussion/Considerations:

- Task team of Shawn Zimmermaker, Curt Cogan and Jim Engel worked on revisions.
- INVL position approved. Discontinuing INTM effective October 1, 2021
- Need to finalize transition plan and to develop a list of qualified INVLs.

- Options are to roll all qualified INTM into INVLs or to add additional criteria to before becoming qualified.
- Anyone working on a task book would need to complete it before October 1, 2021. If not, they'd need to complete the new task book.
- Agencies can add additional agency specific qualification requirements if desired.

Decision: Existing qualified INTMs will be grandfathered in as INVLs barring any agency specific requirements. After October 1, 2021, new INVLs will need to utilize the new position task book.

Topic: INVF and INVL Educational Page

Discussion/Considerations:

- Educational page has gone through several reviews, no timeline for release but it needs further review to ensure it lines up with the material in the new FI-110 and the revisions to PMS 412.
- Updated photographs are still needed. A list of photographs needing updating is located on the Teams file drive.
- Looking for any information on scene sketching and/or mapping.

Topic: FI-210 Learning Portal

Discussion/Considerations:

- Scott is a managing editor within the learning portal. Allows him to create and edit classes within the portal.
- FI-210 learning portal is modeled after the FI-310 learning portal.
- A future class will be set up to provide instruction to all committee members on the use of the learning portal.
- Learning portal contains the pre-work and class requirements the student must pass to earn a certificate.
- Also, the indicator and final examare provided within the learning portal. Test results are immediate.
- Analytical tools allow for review of test material for evaluating a course instruction.
- Students are required to complete feedback prior to getting a certificate.
- Contains reference materials, all of which can be downloaded.

Decision: Revisions still need to be made based off student and instructor feedback. Continue addressing trolling behavior on the learning portal.

Topic: PMS 412 Revision update and tracking changes
