# C. Mitigation Presentation – Sarah McCaffrey

- Social marketing know your target audience and what they care about.
- Messaging is good for awareness (and works for prevention), but does not lead to behavior change/mitigation.
- People understand about risk, but they expect to see planes. Smokey Bear hasn't taught that all fire is bad.
- Fire risk is not a powerful influencer for many people.
- Trust do you know what you are doing? Are you Credible and Competent?
- If you want to change behavior you need to have positive interactions with the public. Relationships change behaviors.
- Do they understand the benefits of action? Ecological Benefits, Risk mitigation, as well as other benefits of action.
- Fire is one of many considerations for people. Generally fire is not high on the list.
  We need to make the issue more salient.
- Outreach has to be tailored according to the social norms of an area.
- Risk tolerance vs Risk Aversion trade off analysis is where we can shift the balance for action.
- Change the paradigm from Fuels Management to what do you value.
